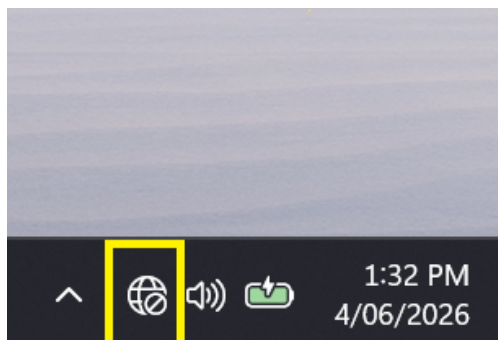


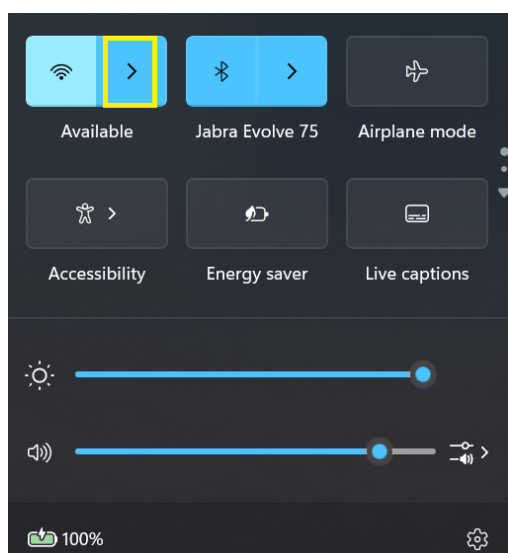
Connect to eduroam Wi-Fi: Windows 11

Follow the below steps to connect to eduroam

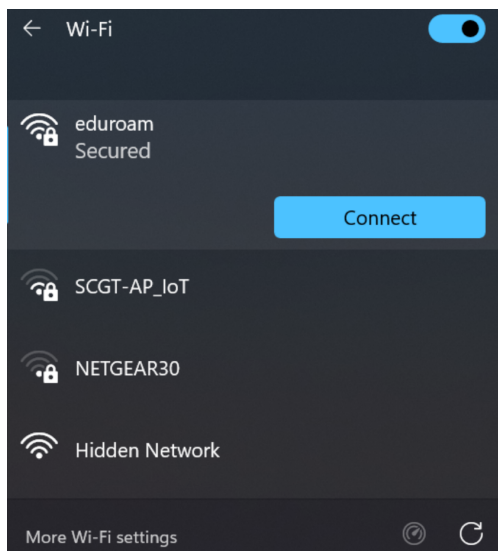
On the desktop, click on the *wireless icon* at the bottom-right of the screen to show the list of networks available.



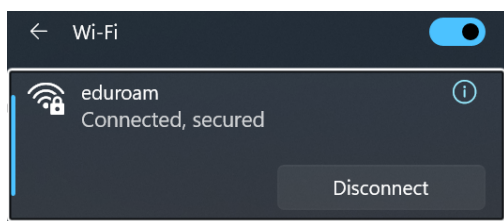
Click the > symbol to see a list of available networks.



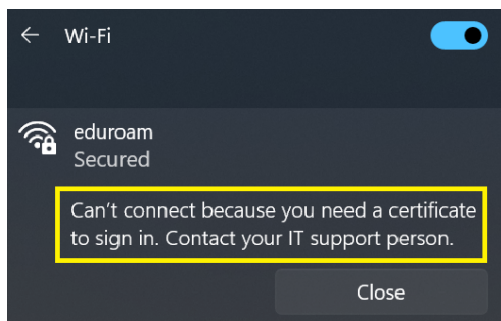
Select **eduroam** from the list of networks displayed.



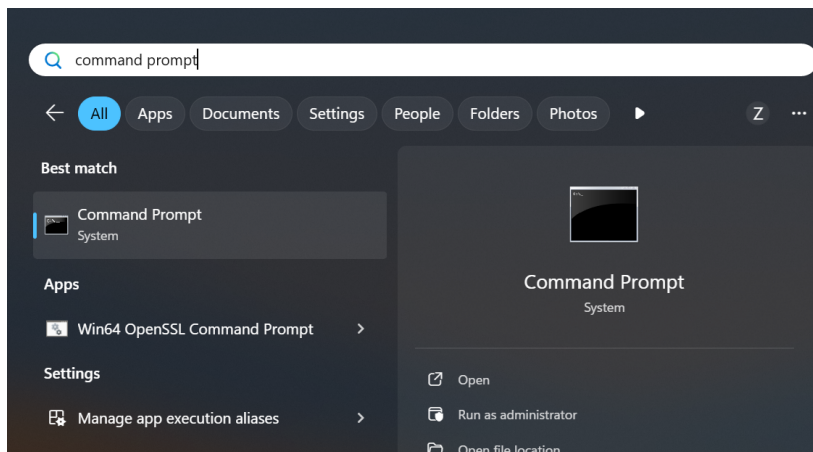
Click on connect and it will connect to eduroam.

In windows search bar, enter "command prompt" and click "open".



Run the below command

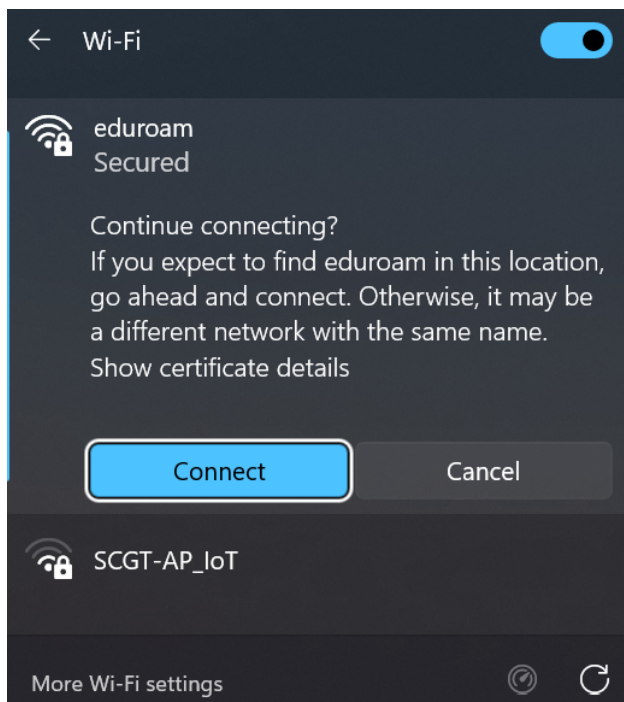
netsh wlan delete profile name="eduroam"

```
Command Prompt
C:\Users>netsh wlan delete profile name="eduroam"
Profile "eduroam" is deleted from interface "Wi-Fi".

```

Once deleted, go to WiFi again and connect using your WIMR email and password. Click "OK"



Click on "Connect"
