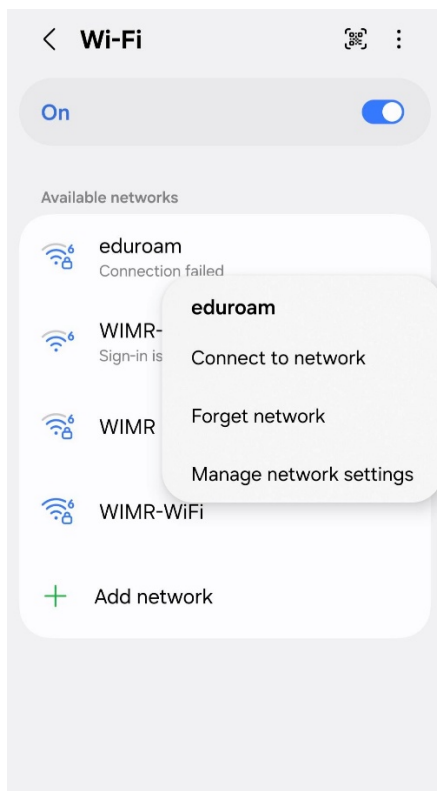


Connect to eduroam wi-fi: Android

Check for a previous connection before starting

If you were previously connected to eduroam, you'll need to follow these two steps before reconnecting.

1. Go to *Wi-Fi settings*
2. Select the information icon for eduroam and click **Forget** or press and hold it, after few seconds, you'll see "Forget Network" on the screen. Click on this



Click on eduroam

Confirm the settings:

- EAP method: **PEAP**
- Phase 2 authentication: **MSCHAPv2**
- CA certificate: **Trust on first use (TOFU)**
- Anonymous identity: **Must** enter email address
